### Our school initiatives are on track to meet or exceed our targets

During 2017, we focused on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students. After reviewing our 2017 Investing for Success agreement, it is clear that we are on track to meet or exceed our targeted student outcomes. We continue to implement our initiatives to ensure that every student succeeds.

Initiatives implemented include:

- Achieving NMS or above in Year 3 and Year 5 in Reading or have an evidence-based learning plan in place to address their specific needs.
- Improving class average scaled scores of students on PAT-R in years 2-6 and individual scores of students working below the expected level by at least 10%
- Achieving a PM Reading Benchmark of 10 or over for all students by the end of Preparatory year, of 18 or over by the end of Year 1, and 28 or over by the end of Year 2, or students will have an evidence-based learning plan in place to address their specific needs.
- Achieving NMS or above in Year 3 and Year 5 in Numeracy or have an evidence-based learning plan in place to address their specific needs.

### Our school initiatives are showing substantial progress toward our targets

After reviewing our 2017 *Investing for Success* agreement, it is clear that we have made progress toward our targeted student outcomes. We will continue to focus on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students, and adjust our initiatives as needed to ensure every student succeeds.

Initiatives implemented include:

- Improving base scores in Writing in Year 1 to Year 6 using NAPLAN marking guides.
- Improving class average scaled scores of students on PAT-M in years 2-6.

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## Our school initiatives have shown limited progress toward our targets



During 2017, limited progress was made toward our targeted student outcomes. We will review our initiatives and make adjustments to better focus on maximising the benefits of Investing for Success funding for our students.

Initiatives implemented include:

- Matching the achievement of students in the upper 2 bands of Reading in years 3 and 5 with like results in Writing for 80% of students, where results have been significantly higher for Reading.
