OSHC Homework Policy

To support families and children, Junction Park State School P&C Association OSHC will endeavour to provide adequate time, quiet space and supervision to enable children to do their homework as necessary, with the express understanding that time in school age care may be the optimal opportunity for homework completion.

Procedures

The Coordinator may create and keep a homework list with the names of children who are to do homework each day.

Children doing homework will be supervised in a quiet environment, away from the other children in the Library. This area also allows children to access the school computers for Matheletics and Reading Eggs.

Educators will assist children with projects and homework to the extent possible, taking into consideration supervision and duty of care issues in relation to the other children in care.

Educators will not be responsible for monitoring and signing off on homework.
